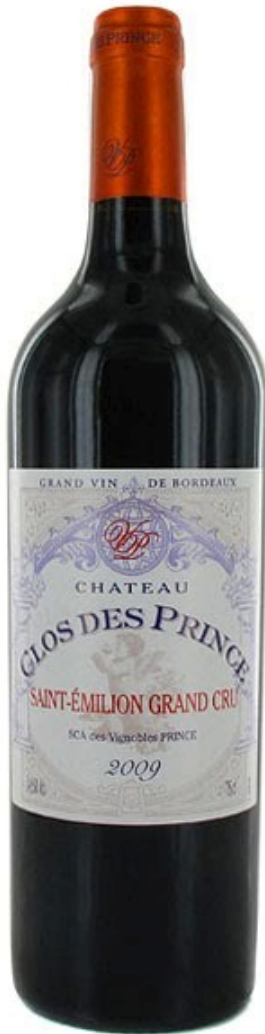


# ESPRIT DU VIN

## SAINT-EMILLION GRAND CRU 2011 BORDEAUX – RIGHT BANK



### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The vineyard of Clos des Princes is at the foot of the famous clay-limestone plateau of Saint Emillion. The vines are more than 50 years, producing a rich, concentrated grape. The Prince family handpicks and sorts the grapes. The wine is then raised more than a year in French oak barrels with 70% new wood.

### DESCRIPTION

The nose is filled with aromas of dark cherry, sweet current, and a toasty component that shows off the cabernet franc. The mouth feel is full and rich. On the palate, flavours of ripened cassis, dark floral notes, and toasted bread lead to the long finish. This drinks amazingly well now, or will last a decade or more.

### SERVING SUGGESTION

Hearty meats and medium fish. Enjoy with firm cheeses and preserves.
