WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Marie-Claire and Pierre Fort, after many years spent in the Loire valley came home to their roots in Limoux and created a tiny, bijou sized estate in a perfect location at one thousand feet above sea level. The vines, mostly chardonnay with a little pinot noir were planted around 40 years ago and are farmed sustainably with the idea of moving towards full organic farming in the years to come.

DESCRIPTION

Pinot noir is seen as the ideal black grape for Limoux and not just for sparkling wine. Here, 40-year-old pinot is made the Burgundian way, full and ripe with a silky texture.
