Winemaker's Notes

Cabardès is a relatively small appellation for the red and rosé wines produced in the hills just north of Carcassonne, southern France. The appellation was introduced in 1999, to represent and ensure the quality of the wines, which have been produced here since Roman times. This Grenache-Merlot-Syrah blend represents a coming-together of the Rhone Valley and Bordeaux.

Description

A beautiful dark garnet color with explosive flavours is very classy and cool with an airy structure. Red fruits, such as pomegranate and red currant, dominate the floral scents of violets, white flowers and notes of white pepper.

Serving Suggestion

It goes well with grilled red meats. This is a well-balanced wine that hides the alcohol flavour and can accompany many everyday dishes, without overpowering.
